Boost is an energizing one-day conference for middle school girls to join together on your campus for an engaging and thought-provoking experience. During Boost, your high school volunteers, who will be trained in advance by Girls' Leadership Camp (GLC) staff, will mentor the younger girls about leadership, self-care, values, confidence and goal-setting. The high school volunteers will serve as team leaders, facilitate ice breakers, and guide debriefing and reflection discussions. This double layer of leadership collaboration between high school students and middle schoolers aims to build big sister/little sister relationships through teambuilding, discussion, and fun!

Boost is an offshoot of the Girls' Leadership Camp, a one-week girls' empowerment camp that, since inception in 2011, has cultivated a strong reputation for offering young women an engaging camp experience to discover themselves and their leadership potential in a safe and inspiring setting. GLC's Program Director and session leaders welcome the opportunity to work with your school in hopes of sharing our passions to cultivate youth empowerment within your community.

Sample schedule:

- 8:30am - Dropoff and Registration
- 9:00am - Kick-off run by GLC
- 9:30am - Small group teambuilding led by high school leaders
- 10:00am - GLC speaker
- 10:45am - Small group debrief and reflection facilitated by high school leaders
- 11:15am - Mid-day energizer run by GLC
- 12:00pm - Lunch
- 12:45pm - GLC speaker
- 1:30pm - Small group debrief and reflection facilitated by high school leaders
- 2:00pm - GLC speaker
- 2:45pm - Small group debrief with snack and reflection facilitated by high school leaders
- 3:15pm - Tour of campus by high school leaders
- 3:45pm - Closing run by GLC
- 4:00pm - Departure

While the above schedule is tried and true as a successful means to infuse young girls with confidence and energy to be the best they can be, the day can be customized to meet your needs.



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Benefits for schools hosting a Boost:

- Excellent means to promote your academic program.
- Intensive Leadership training and inspiration for your high school volunteers

Requirements of schools hosting a Winter Boost:

- Fee for training high school volunteers and facilitating the conference is \$4,000.00 due one week in advance of Boost, with participation limited to 100 middle school aged students.
- Set tuition cost for the day, advertise and facilitate the registration process
- Minimum of 12 female student volunteers from contracted high school
- Minimum of 3 Faculty volunteers who have access and knowledge of campus
- Coverage under school's liability and insurance coverage
- One classroom per group (groups average 10-15)
- Access to at least one large auditorium, or similar setting, with technical support for audio and visual presentation. If 3 auditorium style spaces can be provided, we will rotate groups through sessions yielding smaller and more effective workshops.
- Provide lunch and snack for all attendees, participants and volunteers

Optional: Photobooth and selling of your school swag

Girls' Leadership Camp will provide:

- Marketing assistance
- Three highly endorsed and qualified speakers and trainers
- Materials, supplies & handouts for workshops and GLC led sessions
- GLC Swag sales & raffle prizes
